
How To Play Doubling Dice

- 1. Take a sheet and two dice (dot cubes).
- 2. Roll the dice. Use the numbers to make a two-digit number (ten/ones).

For example, if I roll



I can make 26 or 62.

- 3. Write your number in the "I rolled" box.
- 3. Break your number into "friendly" tens and ones.
- 4. Double your number. Show your work!

Use three dice and make 3-digit numbers (hundreds/tens/ones) to double.
