

"Race to Zero"

Materials: dice (2 or 3), paper

Object of the Game: Subtract to zero before anyone else.

Directions:

- 1) Each player begins with the number 100. Set up a score sheet as shown.
- 2) The first player rolls the dice. Add the dice together and subtract their sum from 100. Record the answer on the score sheet.
- 3) Player two rolls the dice, adds, subtracts the sum from 100, and records the answer on his/her record sheet.
- 4) Continue playing as described above, only subtract the sum of each new roll from the score for each round. Example: Player 1 rolled a 4 and a 5. He adds $4+5=9$, subtracts 9 from 100 to make 91. On his next turn, he rolls $3+6=9$, subtracts 9 from 91 to make 82.
- 5) Keep taking turns playing until someone reaches zero. That person is the winner.
